Your own PCP (Primary Care Physician) is the first person to talk to when you need care for a non-emergency medical condition.

If you have a sudden medical problem and cannot get an appointment to see your regular doctor, an Urgent Care Center is also a good way to get help. Urgent Care Centers are a cost effective way to get non-emergent care. In general, a visit to an Urgent Care Center will cost you eight to ten times less than a visit to the Emergency Room.

Go to the Emergency Room when you think it is necessary.

Urgent Care Centers are a good choice if you can't get in to see your PCP and it is not a life threatening emergency.

A medical emergency usually starts suddenly. The symptoms are bad enough that a person thinks they should get treatment right away. Some examples of emergency conditions are:

- Chest pain or other signs of a heart attack
- Loss of consciousness
- Broken bones
- Cuts that need stitches
- Severe pain
- Drug overdose
- Severe burns
- Any condition that poses a serious risk to a person’s health, bodily function, limbs and organs or the health of a pregnant woman or her unborn child.
- Poisoning
- Convulsions or seizures
- Heavy bleeding
- Sudden weakness on one side of the body
- Breathing problems
- Severe allergic reactions
- Emergency labor and delivery

Urgent Care Centers are a good choice if you can’t get in to see your PCP and it is not a life threatening emergency.
